P&T rep asks about the overview of the requirements. Secretariat clarifies that in the template to e shared the SR requirements are captured at the beginning of the page and the proposed uidance for each requirement follows in the table below. During the consultation process among onstituency/peers, Secretariat recommends to make clear that the SR requirements are not open												

	for revision now, just the guidance. A grower rep asks if we have already received the recommendation from the P&C Review TF on the DLW requirement, as this was their intention in the past when they sent us a letter. Secretariat clarifies that we have not received anything yet and we expect to get any recommendation on updating the SR requirements in line with the new P&C only when the new P&C version is finalised and/or endorsed. Secretariat also informs that the SR Unit was invited to present during the last P&C Review TF on the SR updates and took the opportunity to remind to the TF on which matters we are waiting their feedback; not only the DLW requirement but their feedback on VM when the PC is out and from an individual/member point of view complete their MyRSPO profiles. We keep aligned with the TF and will inform the SRWG when something comes from them.
