Notification of RSPO Re-Certification Assessment of Société Internationale De Plantations Et de Finances – Côte d'Ivoire (SIPEF-CI) – Côte d'Ivoire BOLO Mill

To Whom It May Concern:

Société Internationale De Plantations Et de Finances – Côte d'Ivoire (SIPEF-CI) of Côte d'Ivoire, BOLO Mill, has commissioned SCS Global Services to conduct an RSPO Re-Certification Assessment of its palm oil mill and supply basin located at 37 Km from Sassandra, Subprefecture of Dakpadou, not far from the village of Beyo. The assessment will be conducted of one (1) Palm Oil Mill and one (1) Oil Palm Plantation, 1,576 Outgrowers, 3 Scheme Smallholders.

SCS Global Services plans to conduct the Re-Certification assessment of the Société Internationale De Plantations Et de Finances – Côte d'Ivoire (SIPEF-CI) mill from **March 06**th **to 10**th, **2023**. The assessment will be conducted against the Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil requirements, including the Principles & Criteria (RSPO P&C 2018 including Supply Chain requirement for mills), using as reference the National Interpretation of the P&Cs for the **Côte d'Ivoire of 2020**.

The assessment will cover legal, environment, economical, workers' health and safety, and social aspects as required by the RSPO Principles & Criteria. Below is general information related to the certification unit.
