<u>Public Notification on Upcoming RSPO Certification Assessment of PT First Mujur Plantation & Industry, North Sumatera, Indonesia.</u>

PT First Mujur Plantation & Industry has applied to TUV Rheinland Malaysia Sdn. Bhd. for assessment of one of their holdings against the Roundtable of Sustainable Palm Oil Principles and Criteria – Indonesian National Interpretation (INA-NI). The assessment shall be carried out by a qualified team of auditors to assess legal, environmental, economical, safety and social aspects as covered by the RSPO P&C.

PT First Mujur Plantation & Industry owns and operates one mill for processing the crop from its 3 oil palm estates located in Aek Sigala-gala village, Simangambat sub-district, Padang Lawas district, North Sumatera province, with a total area of 14,150 Ha and total capacity for palm oil mills 61,107 ton per year. PT First Mujur Plantation and Industry is a member of RSPO and has been actively involved in the each Roundtable international conference. PT First Mujur Plantation & Industry is implementing a programme to achieve RSPO Certification for all its palm oil production since August 2008.

Scope of assessment:

The RSPO certification assessment of PT First Mujur Plantation & Industry is scheduled to commence from 25 to 29 January, 2010. The assessment shall be carried out for 1 (one) Palm Oil Mill and 3 (three) Palm Oil Plantations in the North Sumatera region. The details of the oil palm mill and plantations to be assessed are as follows:
