First Resources Limited (RSPO Membership number: 1-0047-08-000-0) has applied to PT SGS Indonesia to conduct RSPO P&C Initial Assessment for one of their management Unit i.e. PT. Muriniwood Indah Industry – Muriniwood Indah Industry Mill, and Supply Bases consist of 1 (one) estate with RSPO ID PalmTrace number: RSPO_PO1000004257.

The Initial Assessment scope is PT. Muriniwood Indah Industry Mill and Muriniwood Indah Industry Estate as supply base located Desa Pamesi, Kecamatan Bathin Solapan, Kabupaten Bengkalis, Prop. Riau - Indonesia against the requirement of RSPO P&C 2018 / National Interpretations for Indonesia , in conjunction with RSPO Certification System 2020 (November 2020).
