Notification on RSPO Initial Assessment (Stage-2) of MSM Palm Oil Mill – PT Mentaya Sawit Mas (WILMAR International Ltd)

Dear Stakeholders,

PT Mutuagung Lestari will conduct Assessment at PT Mentaya Sawit Mas – MSM Palm Oil Mill and its supply base, located in Tangar Village, Mentaya Hulu Sub-district, Kotawaringin Timur District, Central Kalimantan Province, Indonesia against the requirement of the RSPO Standard i.e. National Interpretation of Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil, Principles and Criteria (RSPO INA – NIWG, May 2008) Republic of Indonesia and Supply Chain Requirement for CPO Mill.

WILMAR Int. operates 36 palm oil mills and 46 estates. The organization is a member of RSPO and has been taking an active role in the RSPO certification processes. WILMAR Int is implementing program to achieve RSPO Sustainable Palm Oil requirement for all of its production. Mutuagung Lestari has arranged to conduct the assessment of PT Mentaya Sawit Mas which operating 1 (one) mill and 2 (two) estates on **3-7 November 2014**

Mutuagung Lestari, is also known Mutu Certification International (MUTU), and has started as inspection, laboratory, and Certification body since 1990. As a private national company and supported with highly committed professionals, MUTU has gained recognition nationally and internationally. Since June 2003, MUTU has received recognition from the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry, and Fishery of Japan (MAFF) as registered overseas certification body (ROCB). MUTU certify and mark products with Japan agriculture standard (JAS) covering Indonesia, Myanmar, Cambodia, Malaysia, Vietnam, Timor Leste, Philippines, Papua New Guinea and China. MUTU is the first ROCB in Asia. - f. Other issues related with the assessment
