## <u>Invitation to comment on RSPO Certification Assessment of Minamas Plantation – SIME DARBY GROUP, Indonesia (PT Kridatama Lancar)</u>

Dear Stakeholders,

Sime Darby Plantation Operation in Indonesia collectively called Plantation Upstream Indonesia. PT Minamas Gemilang and PT Anugerah Sumber Makmur managed the operation in Indonesia, known as Minamas Plantation.

MINAMAS Plantation has applied to Mutuagung Lestari for assessment of PT Kridatama Lancar, located in Kalimantan, Indonesia, against the requirement of The National Interpretation of Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil, Principles and Criteria (RSPO INA-NIWG, May 2008), Republic of Indonesia.

MINAMAS owned and operated 23 palm oil mills and 68 estates throughout Indonesia. The organization is a pioneering member of RSPO and has been taking an active role in the RSPO certification processes. MINAMAS Plantation is implementing programme to achieve RSPO Certified Sustainable Palm Oil for all of its production by 31 December 2011.

Mutuagung Lestari has planned to conduct the proposed certification assessment of PT Kridatama Lancar which minimum 30 days prior assessment. (Scheduled on September 20<sup>th</sup>, 2010 – September 25<sup>th</sup>, 2010).

Mutuagung Lestari, as well known as Mutu Certification International was starting as inspection body, laboratory, and certification since 1990 as Private National Company and supported by Professional Human Resources with high commitment as the professional and also already has the acknowledgement from national or international. Since June 2003, Mutu Certification had received the recognition from Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry, and Fishery of Japan (MAFF) as Registered Overseas Certification Body (ROCB) in order to certify for the product that need to be marked as Japan Agricultural Standard (JAS) with the cover area in Indonesia, Myanmar, Cambodia, Malaysia, Vietnam, East Timor, Philippines, Papua New Guinea and China. With this recognition, Mutu Certification becomes the first ROCB in Asia. National Accreditation Body (KAN) has accredited Mutu Certification as Quality Management System Certification Body (ISO 9001:2008) and Environment Management System Certification Body (ISO 14001:2004).
