## <u>Public Notification on upcoming RSPO Certification Assessment of Wilmar International</u> <u>Limited Certification Unit - PT Musi Banyuasin Indah, South Sumatera, Indonesia.</u>

Wilmar International Limited has commissioned PT TUV Rheinland Indonesia for the assessment and certification of one of their holdings in Indonesia against the Roundtable of Sustainable Palm Oil Principles and Criteria – Indonesian National Interpretation (INA-NI). The assessment shall be carried out by a qualified team of auditors to assess the legal, environmental, economic, health & safety and social aspects as covered by the RSPO P&C.

Wilmar International Limited is Asia's leading agribusiness group. Its business activities include oil palm cultivation, edible oils refining, oilseeds crushing, consumer pack edible oils processing and merchandising, specialty fats, oleochemicals and biodiesel manufacturing, and grains processing and merchandising. With a business that spans over 40 countries and backed by a staff force of over 90,000 people, Wilmar International is dedicated to conducting its business in a sustainable manner. This includes engagement through a collaborative process, listening carefully to key stakeholders and addressing their concerns in its business strategies and actions.

Wilmar has been a member of RSPO since September 2005 and is committed to full compliance with the Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil Principles and Criteria (RSPO P&C) and full certification in all aspects of its operations where it possesses a majority share (> 51%).

In line with the RSPO certification system requirement, a time-bound plan to certify all the estates and mills where Wilmar has more than 51% stake by the year ending 2016 has been established.

To demonstrate its commitment in achieving its timebound plan Wilmar announces PT Musi Banyuasin Indah to be amongst the first of its holdings in Sumatera, Indonesia to be assessed against the global RSPO standards framework. Located in the province of South Sumatera, PT Musi Banyuasin Indah has two estates namely Sei Selabu estate and Sei Jarum estate with a total land holding of 4,946.80 ha, of which 4,477.61 ha has been planted. PT Musi Banyuasin Indah Palm Oil mill has a total milling capacity of 60 tonnes/hour.

## Scope of assessment:

The RSPO certification assessment of PT Musi Banyuasin Indah is scheduled to commence from 24 to 28 November 2014. The assessment shall be carried out for 1 (one) Palm Oil Mill and 2 (two) oil palm estates. The details of the oil palm mill and estates to be assessed are as follows:
