Brief information about Applicant	In its application for membership, Watawala began in 1992 when the government of Sri Lanka privatized 22 regional plantation companies growing tea, rubber, coconut and oil palm. Some of them were given to a joint venture between Watawala and Tata Tea Ltd of India, which now grows mainly three crops on 12,442 ha. tea (48%), rubber (10%) and oil palm (21%) with a very small area of coconut, and smaller yet areas of cinnamon, and arecanut. It also manages a farm upcountry with 100 dairy cattle.
	Watawala key strength is its pursuit of excellence, always trying to go beyond even the best practices. This way, it keeps one step ahead of the pack, constantly innovating and bringing about perpetual change from good to great.
