Invitation to comment on RSPO Recertification of PT. Socfin Indonesia - Lae Butar Palm Oil Mill in Nanggro Aceh Darussalam Province, Indonesia.

PT. Socfin Indonesia a subsidiary of Socfin SA with RSPO Membership No. 1-0269-19-000-00, has appointed BSI to conduct RSPO Recertification for its palm oil mill and supply base. The recertification scope will be conducted in one (1) Palm Oil Mill, and one (1) estate. The certification unit is Rimo Village, Gunung Meriah Sub-District, Aceh Singkil Regency, Nanggro Aceh Darussalam Province, Indonesia.

BSI plans to conduct Recertification of PT. Socfin Indonesia - Lae Butar Palm Oil Mill and supply base from 13 - 15 October 2020. The assessment will be conducted based on the Indonesia National Interpretation of RSPO P&C for the Production of Sustainable Palm Oil 2018 (INANI 2020). The assessment will cover legal, environment, economical, workers' health and safety, mill supply chain, social aspects, workers welfare, stakeholder engagement and continuous improvement as required by RSPO P&C.
