



Notification of RSPO Initial Assessment of Industrial Aceitera del Casanare S.A., COLOMBIA RSPO Membership: 2-1189-21-000-00

To Whom It May Concern:

Industrial Aceitera del Casanare S.A. of Colombia has commissioned SCS Global Services to conduct an RSPO Initial Assessment of its palm oil mill and supply basin located near Vereda Mariara Municipio de Orocue, Km 72 Vía Yopal-Algarrobo, Orocue, Casanare, Colombia. The assessment will be conducted of 1 Palm Oil Mill and 5 Oil Palm Plantations.

SCS Global Services plans to conduct the Initial assessment of the Industrial Aceitera del Casanare S.A. mill from **20 to 24 November 2023**. The assessment will be conducted against the Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil requirements, including the Principles & Criteria (RSPO P&C 2018 including Supply Chain requirement for mills), using as reference the National Interpretation of the P&Cs for Colombia, 2020.

The assessment will cover legal, environment, economical, workers' health and safety, and social aspects as required by the RSPO Principles & Criteria. Below is general information related to the certification unit.
