<u>Invitation to comment on RSPO Recertification of PT. Inti Indosawit Subur – Ukui II Palm Oil Mill in Riau Province, Indonesia.</u>

PT Inti Indosawit Subur with RSPO Membership No. 1-0022-06-000-00, has appointed BSI to conduct RSPO Recertification for its palm oil mill and supply base. The recertification scope will be conducted in one (1) Palm Oil Mill, two (2) Estates, and six (6) Cooperatives as Scheme Smallholders. The certification unit is located in Ukui Village, Ukui District, Pelalawan Regency, Riau Province, Indonesia.

BSI plans to conduct Recertification of PT. Inti Indosawit Subur – Ukui II Palm Oil Mill and supply base from 23rd – 30th March 2021. This recertification assessment is a continuation of the remote audit that has been carried out previously with duration to be carried out by 70% of the total audit mandays. The assessment will be conducted based on the RSPO Principles & Criteria for Sustainable Palm Oil Production: Nov 2018, Indonesia National Interpretation 2020. The assessment will cover legal, environment, economical, workers' health and safety, mill supply chain, social aspects, workers welfare, stakeholder engagement and continuous improvement as required by RSPO P&C.
