Sime Darby Plantation Berhad with RSPO Membership No: 1-0008-04-000-00 has appointed BSI to conduct RSPO Recertification Assessment of its Strategic Operating Unit (SOU 24) Hadapan Palm Oil Mill and supply base. The assessment will be conducted at one (1) Palm Oil Mill and four (4) estates. The certification unit is located at Layang-Layang, Johor, Malaysia.

BSI plans to conduct recertification assessment of Strategic Operating Unit (SOU 24) Hadapan Palm Oil Mill and supply base from 07th - 11th December 2020. The assessment will be conducted based on the Malaysia National Interpretation (MYNI) 2019 of the RSPO Principles & Criteria 2018 for Sustainable Palm Oil Production.
