Dear Stakeholders,

MINAMAS Plantation has applied to Mutuagung Lestari for Initial Assessment at PT Sajang Heulang – Mustika Palm Oil Mill and its supply based, located in Village of Kuranji, Sub district of Kuranji, District of Tanah Bumbu, Province of South Kalimantan against the requirement of the SPO Standard i.e. National Interpretation of Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil, Principles and Criteria (RSPO INA – NIWG, May 2008) Republic of Indonesia and Supply Chain Requirment for CPO Mill.

MINAMAS Plantation owned and operated 25 palm oil mills and 68 estates throughout Indonesia. The organization is a pioneer member of RSPO and has been taking an active role in the RSPO certification processes. MINAMAS Plantation is implementing programme to achieve RSPO Certified Sustainable Palm Oil for all of its production. Currently there were 19 (nineteen) Palm Oil Mills under Minamas Plantation have been certified.
