1 What significant economic, social or environmental obstacles have you encountered in the production, procurement, use and/or promotion of CSPO and what efforts did you make to mitigate or resolve them?

The local law set the obligation to make an Environmental and Social Impact Assessment befor land clearence out of 999 hectares; the RSPO requires an ESIA for any land clearence. Regarding our system, with plantation of 4, 11 or 60 hectares, it is expensive to conduct the ESIA. We expect the comming National Interpretation of RSPO P&C will help us find a solution.
