The RSPO certification of smallholders will be done progressively following the RSPO requirement which is to include them within 3 years of the certification of the respective palm oil mill. The first group of smallholders will be targeted for inclusion in 2017 to 2023.

4.5 What are your interim milestones towards achieving RSPO certification commitment (year and progressive CSPO%) - please state annual targets/strategies

Implementation of RSPO P&C is in progress for all operating units in Malaysia and Indonesia. From 2014-2017, the target is to certify the mills and estates in Malaysia. From 2017 to 2020, the target is to certify smallholders supplying to our mills in Malaysia. From 2016 to 2020, the target is to certify the mills and estates in Indonesia. From 2020 to 2023, the target is to certify smallholders supplying to our mills in Indonesia. Meanwhile for our downstream facility (refinery), the target is to certify it with RSPO SCC in 2017.
