
## **Jurisdiction as The Certification Unit**

- Government commitment and involvement as territory manager
- Certification boundaries clearly determine and link with public policy
- Multi-stakeholder process and collaboration
- Mutual cooperation to greatest benefit of all within landscape
- Optimized resources used through integrated and holistic plan and management

#### Give solution to difficult issues such as:

- Small operator such as smallholder to address identification, management and monitoring of HCV, HCS, SEIA, FPIC due to limited data, budget or expertise.
- Lack of management expertise like training, education and experience to fulfil some requirement in managing and achieve sustainable palm oil
- Limited access to data and information access : geographic, environment, social or cultural in order to support best management practices
- Less support from research institution, universities or government services for provide solution and support required to improve sustainability performances.
