- **Mr. Pongrat Khamnungkit:** He will be involved with auditing of environmental management, social aspect, health and safety and workers welfare issues in mill and plantation.
- **Associate Prof Dr. Benchamaporn Pimpa:** She is a technical expert for mill and plantation and good agricultural practices and Integrated Pest Management.


