## Notification on RSPO Main Assessment of PT Sawit Sumbermas Sarana - Sulung Palm Oil Mill and Its Supply Base

Date: 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2018

Dear Stakeholders.

PT SAWIT SUMBERMAS SARANA (RSPO Membership number: 1-0111-07-000-00) has applied to PT SGS Indonesia to conduct RSPO P&C Main Assessment for one of their management Unit i.e. Sulung Palm Oil Mill and its supply base. This Mill and supply bases have been previously RSPO certified, however, due to their RSPO Certificate is due expiry on 18 March 2018, therefore PT SGS Indonesia will renew the certification as Main Assessment.

The Assessment scope is Sulung Palm Oil Mill and four (4) estates as supply bases located at Sulung Village, Arut Selatan Sub-district, Kotawaringin Barat District, Kalimantan Tengah Province – Indonesia; against the requirement of the Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil, Principles and Criteria (RSPO P&C 2013) Indonesian National Interpretation INA-NI (2016) in conjunction with RSPO Certification System 2007 (Amended 2011) and the RSPO Supply Chain Certification Standards and Systems (Revised June 2017) for Palm Oil Mill – Module E: Mass Balance.

The organization is a member of RSPO and has been taking an active role in the RSPO certification processes and planned to achieve RSPO Sustainable Palm Oil requirements for all its production. PT SGS Indonesia has planned to conduct the Main Assessment on 2<sup>nd</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> April 2018.
