<b>Activities undertaken to promote sustainable palm oil to date</b>	We are presently Operating 116 learning centres for 8400 children of workers in oil palm plantations in Sabah. We have reached our goal from 2010 by increasing the number of children with more than 1000. The projects are undertaken in cooperation with most of the leading plantation companies in Sabah as well as many smaller companies. We aim to steadily expand to reach more children and we have in past year managed to increase the number of children at our plantation projects with more than 1000 to the present 8400 children. At this time we are in process of preparing 23 new units of plantation learning centres with plantation companies
