Notification on RSPO Re-certification of Sungai Pinang POM, PT Bina Sains Cemerlang a subsidiary of Sime Darby Plantation Sdn. Bhd. (RSPO Membership: 1-0008-04-000-00)

Dear Stakeholders,

PT Bina Sains Cemerlang – Sime Darby Plantation Sdn. Bhd. (RSPO Membership: 1-0008-04-000-00) – Sungai Pinang POM has applied to Mutuagung Lestari and will conduct Re-certification at Sungai Pinang Palm Oil Mill and its supply base, located in Sungai Pinang Village, Muara Lakitan Sub-district, Musi Rawas District, Sumatera Selatan Province, Indonesia against the requirement of the Indonesian National Interpretation of RSPO Principles and Criteria 2013 by INA-NITF, July 2016 (Endorsed by the RSPO Board of Governors meeting on 30th September 2016) and Supply Chain Requirement for CPO Mill, November 2014.

Sime Darby Plantation Sdn. Bhd. is a member of RSPO and has been taking an active role in the RSPO certification processes and planned to achieve RSPO Sustainable Palm Oil requirement for all of its production. Mutuagung Lestari has arranged to conduct the assessment to the organization which operating 1 (one) palm oil mill and 2 (two) oil palm estate on **08th to 12th August, 2017**.

As a private national company and supported with highly committed professionals, MUTU has gained recognition nationally and internationally. Since June 2003, MUTU has received recognition from the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry, and Fishery of Japan (MAFF) as registered overseas certification body (ROCB).
