Genting Plantations Bhd. has applied to SGS (Malaysia) Sdn. Bhd. and will conduct Initial-Certification Assessment at Genting Sabapalm Oil Mill and its supply base Genting Sabapalm Estate located in Beluran, Sabah against the requirement of the Roundtable on Sustainable Palm Oil, Principles and Criteria (RSPO P&C 2013) and in line with the Malaysian National Interpretation (MYNI 2014) and the RSPO Supply Chain Certification Systems (SCCS 2014) document for Palm Oil Mill.

The organization is a member of RSPO and has been taking an active role in the RSPO certification processes and planned to achieve RSPO Sustainable Palm Oil requirement for all of its production.
