Brief information about Applicant	The Division spans across Peninsular Malaysia as well as Sabah and Sarawak; Kalimantan, Sumatera and Sulawesi in Indonesia; Liberia; Papua New Guinea and Solomon Islands. Currently, the company has a total land bank of approximately 1 million hectares, of which more than 600,000 ha are planted with oil palm, 11,000 ha with rubber, 5,000 ha with sugar cane and 9,000 ha of grazing pastures. Tanah Merah POM is located in Port Dickson, Negeri Sembilan and have two (2) supply bases which are Tanah Merah Estate and Bukit Pelandok Estatge.


