To Whom It May Concern:

Okomu Oil Palm Company PLC, Extension 2 of Nigeria has commissioned SCS Global Services to conduct an RSPO Certification Assessment of its palm oil mill and supply base located at Ovia North-East Local Government Area, Benni City, Edo State – Nigeria. The assessment will be conducted on 1 Palm Oil Mill and 1 Oil Palm Plantation.
